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## Mock Analysis Tips & Tricks

Stage	Analysis Area	Description
Section-wise Analysis	Strengths & Weaknesses	Identify high scoring sections and topics needing improvement. Analyze your question selection strategy (prioritizing strengths vs sequential attempts).
Question-wise Analysis	Correct Attempts	Review for potential time-saving techniques. Did you spend unnecessary time?
Question-wise Analysis	Incorrect Attempts (Conceptual Errors)	Revisit misunderstood concepts. Practice similar problems for better understanding.
Question-wise Analysis	Incorrect Attempts (Calculation Errors)	Sharpen calculation skills. Practice basic math and identify careless mistakes.
Question-wise Analysis	Incorrect Attempts (Time Pressure)	Analyze reasons for running out of time. Develop time management strategies per section.
Question-wise Analysis	Unattempted Questions	Attempt these yourself first. Review solutions to understand the thought process. Identify knowledge gaps.
Overall Analysis	Time Management	Evaluate time spent on each section. Did you follow your planned strategy?
Overall Analysis	Test-Taking Strategies	Assess your approach to the mock. Did you stay calm under pressure? Identify unexpected challenges.
