Selection Process	Description
Group Discussion (GD)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A case or a group activity is given to the group of students. Students has to discuss & to come up with a solution.
Written Ability Test (WAT)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 questions are given to each student. Each question has to be written of 100-200 words. Total time given 5-10 mins.
Personal Interview (PI)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> it is a in persona interaction with the panel of the college the student is applying for

1. Candidate Registration	Candidates register for participation in the Centralised Admission Process (CAP) 2021.
2. Filling Online Application	Candidates fill out the online application form for CAP 2021, indicating their preferences for courses and institutions.

4. Publishing of Merit Lists	Provisional merit lists are displayed, grievances are submitted and addressed, and final merit lists are published.
