## Get to know CUET PG

Hey! Everyone...Welcome to CATKing Family.

I am here to guide you about CUET. So, what exactly is CUET PG?

The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) PG exam is conducted by the National Testing Agency for students who wish to take admission to postgraduate courses at different Central Universities and other participating colleges. The CUET PG exam selection process includes the online written examination along with the counselling round. The CUET PG counselling is conducted by participating institutes for candidates who pass the online written examination. A total of 142 universities participated in the CUET PG exam in 2023. Top universities that participate in CUET PG exam are Delhi University, Banaras Hindu University, All Central Universities, IIMC New Delhi, GGS IP University, Jamia Milia Islamia, IIT Lucknow, IITM, Delhi Technological Universities and others.

## Now, Lets see the key highlights of CUET PG

- Candidates can select only one paper in one slot.
- An applicant can apply for three (03) test papers by paying an application fee.
- An applicant can further apply for more than three test papers, candidates must pay an additional fee (as applicable).
- Exams will be conducted on multiple days in two slots.
- The question paper will have 100 questions comprising of Language Comprehension/Verbal Ability, Mathematical/Quantitative Ability, Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning.
- Candidate has to attempt Verbal Ability/Language Comprehension in one language only i.e. Either English or Hindi. The remaining question would be Bilingual.

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# Now Let's have a look on CUET PG Preparation Strategy

## **Prioritization and Focus:**

While all sections contribute to the score, Verbal Ability (VA) and Quantitative Aptitude (Quant) hold greater weightage. Devoting an hour each to VA and Quant reflects this importance.

## **Verbal Ability:**

- Reading Comprehension: Master this skill by tackling a variety of passages regularly. CATKing LOD-1 and Norman Lewis are valuable resources.
- Vocabulary Building: Diligently work through Norman Lewis to expand your word power.

## **Data Interpretation (DI):**

- Focus on Pie Charts and Tables: Proficiency in interpreting data presented visually is crucial. Practice questions based on pie charts, bar graphs, and tables from CATKing LOD-1.

## **Quantitative Aptitude:**

- Arithmetic is Key: Brush up on fundamental concepts like Time & Speed, Distance, Simple & Compound Interest, Percentages, Profit & Loss from CATKing LOD-1.

## **Logical Reasoning:**

- Practice Regularly: Dedicate one hour daily to solve Logical Reasoning problems from CATKing LOD-1.

## **The Importance of Practice:**

- Solve Mock Tests and Previous Year Papers: Regularly attempt CATKing mock tests and analyze your performance to identify strengths and weaknesses.
- Time Management: Practice solving questions within the stipulated time frame to develop exam temperament.
